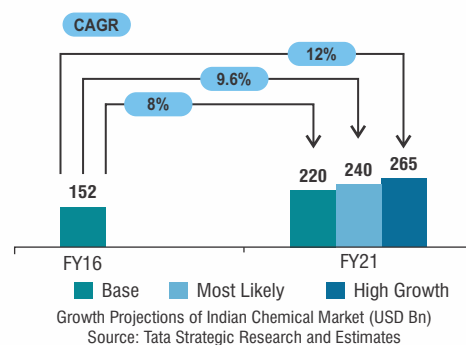

**I**ndian Chemical Market is estimated to be USD 152 Bn in FY16 and is likely to grow at 9.6% p.a. over the next 5 years to reach USD 240 Bn by FY21. At the same time, the Indian Speciality Chemicals market will grow @ 13% CAGR and is expected to be of the size US \$ 85 Bn by FY 2025, thus creating huge opportunities for the chemical industry in India. It is important that this enhanced demand is met by domestic manufacturing, in the process not only translating the "Make in India" effort into reality, but also creating jobs in the country.



However the chemical industry continues to face several challenges. The same includes Availability of feedstock at competitive rates, Lack of domestic manufacturing of several intermediates which increases lead times and lowers competitiveness of downstream producers. Lack of adequate physical infrastructure and sub-par chemical logistics which makes material production and movement cost intensive. To add to above, significant glut in global chemical capacities has led to growth of imports in India. Large capacity additions in Middle East and USA are also cause of concern for the domestic players. The duty structure needs rationalization for several products value chain in order to boost domestic value addition. PCPIRs implementation is yet to take off as expected.

There is need to address these challenges to facilitate domestic manufacturing. Over the past two decades, Gujarat has become one of the most preferred locations for industrial development in India especially for chemical industry. There are many factors for same but the key differentiating factor has been its investor friendly policies towards industrial development and geographically proximity to resource rich "Middle East".
